


TREES


We get fresh water from the forest.




The forest helps clean the air.




The forest gives homes and food to many animals.




The forest makes it possible for us to have homes too.

Some trees have thin leaves called needles that stay green all year.






Trees change every season.






People go into the forest and harvest trees.




